CONCLUSION

Socialization regarding ethics in using social media and social media rules in the ITE Law can be concluded that as a user of social media in interacting you must first know the ethics of using social media such as in communicating, including avoiding SARA (Ethnicity, Religion, Race) and knowing the applicable rules. in ethics on social media, namely in articles 27 to 30 of the ITE Law.
